Comment

AT	In Austria, kindergarten do not belong to the school sector. The numer of kindergartens is only an estimate not included in the total of schools. The mentioned percentage only concerns pupils in schools strictly speaking.
DE	The German statistics do not include kindergartens.
GB (E&W)	England : 440,264 pupils in 1,728 primary schools and 382,740 pupils in 414 secondary schools. Total 823,004 pupils and 2,142 schools (10%). Wales: 15,270 pupils in 71 primary schools and 14,047 pupils in 17 secondary schools. Total 29,317 pupils and 88 schools (6%). For both England and Wales, the figures mentioned in the secondary level include 1 tertiary school and 1 all through school.
HR	Kindergartens are not part of the school system in Croatia. A school reform is in the process and afterwards kindergartens will be an integral part of the process of students education. There are 52 kindergarten with a total of 2,993 children.
HU	As for the age of pupils, kindergarten welcomes children from 3 to 6 years old. The second column concerns children from 6 to 14 and higher secondary includes pupils from 14 to 18. There are about twenty lyceums for pupils from 10 to 18, and another twenty for pupils from 15 to 18.
IE	Kindergarten schools are non-denominational business in Ireland. While overall percentage of school-going population in Catholic schools is 75.07%, the primary percentage is 90% and the secondary percentage is 47.60%.
NL	The Netherlands only publish statistics for all education. The data mentioned are an estimate of the part of Catholic education in this total (that is about 30% in primary and 20% in secondary education).
PT	In Portugal, primary school is divided into 3 cycles for pupils from 6 to 15 years old. Secondary school has pupils from 15 to 18 years old.
SI	In Slovenia kindergarten is attended by 78% of children between the ages of 1 and 6. The nine year compulsory primary education includes children from 6 to 15. Secondary education takes three or four years from 15 to 18 or 19. The percentage of children in Catholic kindergartens is 2,0%, primary schools 0,3% and secondary schools 2,1%.
Figures in red colour mentioned as total of pedagogical entities (= schools per education level) for CH, DE and IE were not provided by member countries. We took the liberty to complete this column assuming that the number of pedagogical entities corresponded to the number of administrative entities.
